

Who is Eligible For Medicare?

- People 65 yrs old,
- Must be a U.S. citizen or legal resident,
- People who are under 65 and have a disability.
- People in Permanent Kidney Failure. (ESRD)



Things to know about the "age 65" rule:

- Even if you're already collecting Social Security, you must wait until you're 65 to enroll in Medicare.
- If Not collecting Social Security yet, you will be eligible to join Medicare Parts A and B at age 65.
- If you have been on Disability for 24 months, You may automatically be enrolled into Medicare.

When someone becomes eligible based on age, they should receive a Letter from the federal government.

NOTE:

If you have coverage through a union or employer, you may want to delay Part B enrollment, since there is a premium associated with Part B.
